Summary

Hof Ashkelon Regional Council offers two high-quality communities: Netiv HaAsara - a close-knit community with developed community services and education from ages 0–18, and Gevaram - a secular kibbutz with formal and informal education systems and rich cultural life. Both communities are located in relative proximity to central Israel and offer a high-quality community environment.
