In-Demand Specialties

Rehabilitation physicians, residents, physiotherapists, speech therapists, occupational therapists, rehabilitation psychologists, and social workers are needed.

The center offers financial incentives, subsidized housing, professional mentoring, and dedicated training for clinical teams.

Professional and Personal Development

The center enables physicians to take part in research, innovation and entrepreneurship, medical education, and multidisciplinary projects. Support is available for fellowships and advanced professional development, according to the needs of the center and the employee.

Medical and Managerial Leadership

Management training, skills courses, and mentoring are offered to develop professional and managerial leadership among physicians and staff.

Research

ADI Negev has research collaborations with Ben-Gurion University, the Weizmann Institute, and Shirley Ryan AbilityLab. The center operates a research institute with an internal Helsinki Committee. Physicians and staff take part in clinical research, medical entrepreneurship, and the development of innovative solutions, alongside grants for research and training.

Innovation

The center operates an Innovation and Entrepreneurship Center led by Yossi Shavit. Physicians and staff receive guidance and mentoring for developing ideas, initiatives, and technologies in the field of rehabilitation.

Staff Well-Being

The center operates resilience and burnout-prevention programs, activities for multidisciplinary teams, professional support from senior physicians, and employment flexibility, including the option of an elective outside the institution.

Academia and Medical Education

The center offers residency in physical medicine and rehabilitation. It maintains collaborations with higher education institutions in the fields of physiotherapy, occupational therapy, and speech therapy, as well as residency in rehabilitation psychology. ADI Negev operates Israel's first academic degree program in orthotics and prosthetics.

Scholarships and Incentives

The center participates in the Kohavim Program, provides housing assistance, and supports the professional and educational development of its staff.

Future Opportunities

The center is expected to open a new research and innovation center, an advanced training center, an MRI institute, and new rehabilitation departments, enabling accelerated professional development and expansion of its areas of activity.
